Connection Class

Christ has given us clear direction for building relationships with our families, our friends, our communities and our God. As a class we seek to 'connect' with other Christians growing in their commitment to Christ through Bible studies relevant for today's fast-paced world. Our goal is to broaden Christian knowledge to develop better friendships, spouses, parents, and individual followers of Christ. The Connections Class is a very informal class – all are welcome! We seek out Bible studies that help provide a foundation for Christian character. The class meets in the classroom adjacent to the Children's Department on the lower level of Bethlehem Church.



Searchers

The Searchers Class is a lecture/discussion class. We are presently studying six of the thirty-four miracles of Jesus using the DVD series Deeper Connections. In our weekly lessons, we use the Bible to find encouraging and challenging applications for our daily lives. Later in the year we will be using Bill Fay's book, Share Jesus Without Fear; this study will help provide freedom and encouragement in the sharing of our faith. We welcome you to come join us in these studies and to grow in your journey of faith and in your knowledge of the Scripture. Our class meets off Wesley Hall near the library on the main floor of Bethlehem Church.

NEW Membership Classes

Orientation classes are held periodically for new members of Bethlehem. Dates and locations are announced in the church bulletin and newsletter.

Adult Bible Class

The Adult Bible Class studies lessons based on selected passages of Scripture. After we read the weekly text from the Uniform Series quarterly, our teacher presents a lesson that illustrates the biblical setting as it parallels with our culture in the present day. Cultures change; God does not. By drawing comparisons between ancient and modern times, we learn that the lessons of the Bible are always relevant. Visitors and new class members are always welcome! You will find our classroom on the west side of Wesley Hall.

Fellowship Class

The Fellowship Class is an informal discussion group. We select a variety of topics – books of the Bible, Bible leaders, or life topics. These studies may last from 4 to 12 weeks. In our fellowship, we share God's truths and encourage each other in our Christian journey. Come meet around the coffee pot in Fellowship Hall on Bethlehem Church's lower level.
